

City Council Meeting Minutes

January 4, 2021

The meeting of the Frontenac City Council, January 4, 2021, was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Mayor Fornelli. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

Roll call was answered by Mayor David Fornelli, LaDonna Pyle, Lynn Grant, Joe Martin, Pat Clinton, and David Hogard. Tom Sighel, Mike Snow, and Marc McCully were absent.

Also present was the Police Chief, Fire Chief, Public Works Director, City Attorney, City Administrator, and City Clerk.

Hogard made a motion, seconded by Clinton to approve the agenda. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Minutes from the December 21, 2020 council meeting was opened for discussion. Hogard made a motion, seconded by Grant, to approve the minutes. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Appropriation Ordinance #1782 was opened for discussion. A motion to approve Appropriation Ordinance #1782 was made by Martin, seconded by Pyle. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Citizen's Comments:

Shelly Hipfl, 506 Wilson Street, asked the Council to look into an anti-tethering ordinance to prevent the long-term tethering of animals.

City Administrator's Report:

Zafuta updated the Council on the following:

- 2021 Water and Sewer Rates.

Council Members' Comments:

Pyle asked if the City has received any update on opening the Public Rec Center, Zafuta stated that he had submitted a plan to the County Health Officer and will make contact again to see what the status is.
