

City Council Meeting Minutes

January 19, 2021

The meeting of the Frontenac City Council, January 19, 2021, was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Mayor Fornelli. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

Roll call was answered by Mayor David Fornelli, Tom Sighel, LaDonna Pyle, Mike Snow, Marc McCully, Lynn Grant, Joe Martin, and David Hogard. Pat Clinton was absent.

Also present was the Police Chief, Fire Chief, Public Works Director, City Attorney, City Administrator, and City Clerk.

Pyle made a motion, seconded by Hogard to approve the agenda. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Minutes from the January 4, 2021 council meeting was opened for discussion. Hogard made a motion, seconded by Grant, to approve the minutes. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Appropriation Ordinance #1783 was opened for discussion. A motion to approve Appropriation Ordinance #1783 was made by Grant, seconded by Sighel. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

The Council continued the discussion on anti-tethering of dogs, this topic was tabled to the February 16th meeting to get additional opinions.

Pyle made a motion, seconded by Snow to approve Ordinance 2021-01, Water and Sewer Rates for 2021. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

At 7:03 pm, Pyle motioned, seconded by Snow, to recess into executive session for 10 minutes for the Preliminary Discussion of the Acquisition of Real Property related to the US 69 Highway and McKay Street Project. The session included the City Council, Mayor, City Administrator, City Clerk, and City Attorney. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

At 7:13 pm, the Council returned to regular session with no action being taken.

At 7:14 pm, Pyle motioned, seconded by Snow, to recess into executive session for 20 minutes for the Preliminary Discussion of the Acquisition of Real Property related to the North Industrial Park. The session included the City Council, Mayor, City Administrator, City Clerk, City Attorney, and the Director of Public Works. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

At 7:34 pm, the Council returned to regular session with no action being taken.

- Paving for 2021


Council Members' Comments:

Pyle asked if the house located in Capaldo was zoned Commercial or Residential. Zafuta stated that once property is annexed the zoning automatically defaults to residential.


With no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Snow, seconded by Sighel. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.
