

City Council Meeting Minutes

February 1, 2021

The meeting of the Frontenac City Council, February 1, 2021, was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Mayor Fornelli. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

Roll call was answered by Mayor David Fornelli, Tom Sighel, LaDonna Pyle, Mike Snow, Marc McCully, Lynn Grant, Joe Martin, Pat Clinton, and David Hogard.

Also present was the Police Chief, Fire Chief, Public Works Director, City Attorney, City Administrator, and City Clerk.

Snow made a motion, seconded by Sighel to approve the agenda. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Minutes from the January 19, 2021 council meeting was opened for discussion. Pyle made a motion, seconded by Grant, to approve the minutes. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Appropriation Ordinance #1784 was opened for discussion. A motion to approve Appropriation Ordinance #1784 was made by McCully, seconded by Martin. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

McCully made a motion, seconded by Snow to approve the purchase of a Dodge Charger Patrol Vehicle from Jay Hatfield of Frontenac in the amount of \$29,182.00. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Pyle made a motion, seconded by Clinton to approve the CDBG-CV Grant Awarded to A-1 Air in the amount of \$18,215.19. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Snow made a motion, seconded by Grant to approve the CDBG-CV Grant Awarded to A. Lusker Masonry in the amount of \$18,215.19. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Clinton made a motion, seconded by Martin to approve the CDBG-CV Grant Awarded to JLMS Properties in the amount of \$18,215.19. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Martin made a motion, seconded by Grant to approve the CDBG-CV Grant Awarded to Mid-America Roofing in the amount of \$18,215.19. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Hogard made a motion, seconded by Martin to approve the CDBG-CV Grant Awarded to Mid-America Sanitation in the amount of \$16,108.85. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Sighel made a motion, seconded by Snow to approve the CDBG-CV Grant Awarded to Payne's Inc. in the amount of \$18,215.19. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Pyle made a motion, seconded by Grant to approve the CDBG-CV Grant Awarded to Wiseman's Tire in the amount of \$18,215.19. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

At 6:43 pm, Pyle motioned, seconded by Snow, to recess into executive session for 5 minutes for the Preliminary Discussion of the Acquisition of Real Property related to the US 69 Highway and McKay Street Project. The session included the City Council, Mayor, City Administrator, City Clerk, and City Attorney. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

At 6:48 pm, the Council returned to regular. Pyle made a motion, seconded by Snow to allow the City Administrator and the Mayor to negotiate and execute contracts for the purchasing of property located at 5011 Parkview Drive and 806 West McKay Street. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

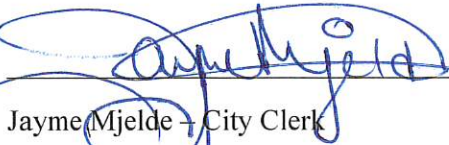
City Attorney Angermayer gave an update on information he had received from two different veterinarians regarding the tethering of dogs.
