

City Council Meeting Minutes

December 20, 2021

The meeting of the Frontenac City Council, December 20, 2021, was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Mayor David Fornelli. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

Roll call was answered by Mayor David Fornelli, Tom Sighel, LaDonna Pyle, Marc McCully, Lynn Grant, Joe Martin, Pat Clinton, and Kyle Smalley. Mike Snow was absent.

Also present was the Fire Chief, Police Chief, Public Works Director, City Attorney, City Administrator, and City Clerk.

Sighel made a motion, seconded by Clinton to approve the agenda. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Minutes from the December 6, 2021, council meeting was opened for discussion. Pyle made a motion, seconded by Grant, to approve the minutes. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Appropriation Ordinance #1805 was opened for discussion. A motion to approve Appropriation Ordinance #1805 was made by Grant, seconded by Martin. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Clinton made a motion, seconded by McCully to approve the 2022 CMB License Renewal for EAT Palluccas. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Clinton made a motion, seconded by McCully to approve the 2022 CMB License Renewal for Pete's of Erie. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Clinton made a motion, seconded by McCully to approve the 2022 CMB License Renewal for EK Enterprise. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

At 6:32 pm, Pyle motioned, seconded by Clinton, to recess into executive session for 20 minutes for attorney client privilege regarding property negotiations. The session included the City Council, Mayor, City Clerk, City Attorney and City Administrator. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

At 6:52 pm, the Council returned to regular session with no action being taken.

At 6:55 pm, Pyle motioned, seconded by McCully, to recess into executive session for 10 minutes for non-elected personnel regarding a police employee. The session included the City Council, Mayor, City Clerk, City Attorney, Police Chief, and City Administrator. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

At 7:05 pm, the Council returned to regular session. McCully made a motion, seconded by Grant to promote Adam Harrison to Assistant Police Chief with a salary increase to \$52,250.00 effective immediately. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

At 7:06 pm, Pyle motioned, seconded by Clinton, to recess into executive session for 10 minutes for non-elected personnel regarding a municipal court employee. The session included the City Council, Mayor, City Clerk, City Attorney, Police Chief, and City Administrator. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

At 7:16 pm, the Council returned to regular session. Pyle made a motion, seconded by Sighel to hire John Mazurek as the Municipal Court Judge. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Council Members' Comments

Mayor Fornelli asked the Council to approve a 3% COLA. Clinton made a motion, seconded by Grant to approve a 3% COLA for city employees. The motion was voted upon and approved by the Council. Martin abstained.

Sighel wished everyone a Merry Christmas and Happy New Year.

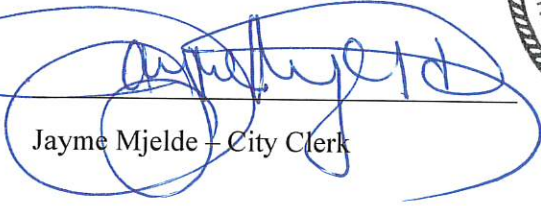
Martin thanked Zafuta and Fornelli for their representation at the County Commission meeting regarding the ARPA funds.
