

City Council Meeting Minutes

December 6, 2021

The meeting of the Frontenac City Council, December 6, 2021, was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Mayor David Fornelli. Kyle Smalley was sworn into office by Mayor Fornelli. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

Roll call was answered by Mayor David Fornelli, Tom Sighel, LaDonna Pyle, Mike Snow, Lynn Grant, Joe Martin, Pat Clinton, and Kyle Smalley. Marc McCully was absent.

Also present was the Fire Chief, Police Chief, Public Works Director, City Attorney, City Administrator, and City Clerk.

Clinton made a motion, seconded by Grant to approve the agenda. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Minutes from the November 15, 2021, council meeting was opened for discussion. Pyle made a motion, seconded by Snow, to approve the minutes. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Appropriation Ordinance #1804 was opened for discussion. A motion to approve Appropriation Ordinance #1804 was made by Grant, seconded by Clinton. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Public Hearing

At 6:33 Mayor Fornelli opened the public hearing for the 2021 budget amendment. There were no public comments, Mayor Fornelli closed the public hearing at 6:34 p.m.

Snow made a motion, seconded by Martin to approve the 2021 budget amendment. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Pyle made a motion, seconded by Sighel to approve the 2021 budget amendment amount to be transfers to the capital reserve fund. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Clinton made a motion, seconded by Grant to approve Ordinance 2021-13 sales tax. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Mayor Fornelli welcomed Kyle Smalley. He applauded all the volunteers for making the Christmas tree lighting such a success.


