

City Council Meeting Minutes

January 18, 2022

The meeting of the Frontenac City Council, January 18, 2022, was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Mayor David Fornelli. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

Roll call was answered by Mayor David Fornelli, Tom Sighel, Mike Snow, Marc McCully, Lynn Grant, Joe Martin, Pat Clinton, Kyle Smalley. LaDonna Pyle was absent.

Also present was the Fire Chief, Police Chief, Public Works Director, City Attorney, City Administrator, and City Clerk.

McCully made a motion, seconded by Snow to approve the agenda. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Minutes from the January 4, 2021, council meeting was opened for discussion. Grant made a motion, seconded by Clinton, to approve the minutes. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Appropriation Ordinance #1807 was opened for discussion. A motion to approve Appropriation Ordinance #1807 was made by Sighel, seconded by Martin. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Snow made a motion, seconded by McCully, to elect Pat Clinton as the Council President. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Brannon Green with Assured Partners gave a high-level overview of the current insurance coverage the city has, as well as steps taken throughout the past year to improve the city's exposure.

Trey Coleman with the Knights of Columbus asked for the Council to approve a CMB Special Event License for the Knights of Columbus to be able to serve cereal malt beverages at their Friday Lenten fish fries. Zafuta informed the Council that the city will need to amend its current ordinance regarding CMB Licensing to give the power to issue special event permits. The Council directed Zafuta to draft the amendment for them to approve at the next meeting.

Snow made a motion, seconded by Grant, to approve Resolution 2022-01 GAAP Waiver. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Snow made a motion, seconded by Martin, to approve the payout of Wade Curlee's remaining vacation and sick leave. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Mayor Fornelli thanked Cussimano and his crew for working through the weekend on snow removal and treating the streets.


Snow stated that the Elementary Librarian Ann Brown is interested on being a member of the Library Board.
