

City Council Meeting Minutes

April 18, 2022

The meeting of the Frontenac City Council, April 18, 2022, was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Mayor David Fornelli. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

Roll call was answered by Mayor David Fornelli, LaDonna Pyle, Tom Sighel, Mike Snow, Marc McCully, Lynn Grant, Joe Martin, Pat Clinton, Kyle Smalley.

Also present was the Fire Chief, Police Chief, Public Works Director, City Attorney, City Administrator, and City Clerk.

Snow made a motion, seconded by Clinton to approve the agenda. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Appropriation Ordinance #1813 was opened for discussion. A motion to approve Appropriation Ordinance #1813 was made by McCully, seconded by Sighel. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Citizen's Comments

Kristina Cullison with USD 249 and Kari Cronister gave a high-level presentation on the childcare needs in our community. They are applying for grants to fund their project and would like to create a partnership with the City.

Rob Little, 101 W. North County Rd, addressed the Council with his concerns regarding the property that had a recent fire, located next to his property.

Kristina Cullison with USD 249, stated that they received some grant funding for another pre-school classroom and are looking for a space that would be available from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. They are interested in the Senior Citizen Center, Mjelde stated she would email them contact information for the board.

Snow made a motion, seconded by Pyle, to approve the hiring of Gordon Gregory for the Municipal Court Judge. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

McCully made a motion, seconded by Grant, to approve moving forward with the sewer project on North County Road. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.


