

## City Council Meeting Minutes

July 18, 2022

The meeting of the Frontenac City Council, July 18, 2022, was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Council President Pat Clinton. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

Roll call was answered by, LaDonna Pyle, Tom Sighel, Mike Snow, Lynn Grant, Pat Clinton, and Kyle Smalley. Mayor David Fornelli, Marc McCully, and Joe Martin were absent.

Also present was the Assistant Police Chief, Fire Chief, Public Works Director, City Attorney, City Administrator, and City Clerk.

Sighel made a motion, seconded by Grant to approve the agenda. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Minutes from the July 5, 2022, council meeting was opened for discussion. Pyle made a motion, seconded by Smalley, to approve the minutes. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Appropriation Ordinance #1819 was opened for discussion. A motion to approve Appropriation Ordinance #1819 was made by Grant, seconded by Snow. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

### **Resolution 2022-07**

Motion made by Pyle, seconded by Snow to approve Resolution 2022-07, FESTA Italiana Alcohol Consumption. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

### **Lease Agreement**

Motion made by Grant, seconded by Smalley to approve the lease agreement for FESTA Italiana. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

### **Budget Work Session**

Zafuta gave the Council a high-level overview of the proposed 2023 budget.

Motion made by Pyle, seconded by Snow to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate. The motion was voted upon and approved by the Council with 4 yes votes, Sighel abstained from the vote.

Snow asked if the situation at the property located at 103 W. North County Road has improved. Angermayer gave an update regarding the property in question.


**Council Members' Comments**

Grant stated that she was pleased with the paving in Capaldo.


With no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Sighel, seconded by Smalley. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.
