

City Council Special Meeting Minutes

August 19, 2026

The special meeting of the Frontenac City Council, August 19, 2026 was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Steve Morrison. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

Roll call was answered by Steve Morrison, Nick Hansen, Joe Martin, Pat Clinton, Tom Sighel, Karen Holland, LaDonna Pyle, and Kyle Smalley. Marc McCully was absent.

Also present was the City Attorney, City Administrator, and City Clerk.

Sighel made a motion, seconded by Clinton, to approve the agenda. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the council.

Hansen made a motion, seconded by Pyle, to resend the motion made in August 12th to take affirmative action in the form of a filed claim in the pending court case or a recorded deed on 5011 Parkview Dr. The motion was voted upon by roll call and passed with a 6 to 1 vote. 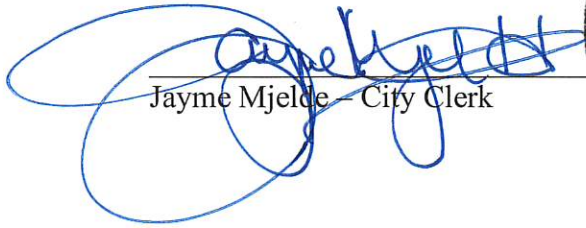
Sighel stated that he understands where this is going, we did not do justice to the people in Frontenac, Kansas with this land contract at 5011 Parkview Dr.
